These fingerless mitts are filled with twists, swirls, and garter stitch texture. The top hand part can be made with lacy chevrons or a simple eyelet and garter design, worked sideways until it fits perfectly around your hand with stitches left along the edge for the modular construction. Then decreases and twisted stitches twirl around as yarn overs create lines and triangles down the wrist. The swirling design twists down, starting with the thumb gusset, then down to the other side and back - this symmetrical design makes for one single mitt pattern for both hands.

This pattern is a part of Lee Meredith's Remixed collection, which is all about making and using recycled yarns, with knit accessory designs meant to work well with those unique yarns, due to their flexible gauge and sizing.
