

# Remixed



This scarf is a simple pattern, but by using leftover yarn bits to work each row in a different color (and/or texture/weight), you'll make a completely unique piece for your neck. The garter-stitch-esque stitch pattern is worked asymmetrically with basic short rows (no need to wrap, since there is no turning!) making one end twice the width of the other. Worked lengthwise, always in the same direction, every row starts at the same end, tails left along both edges for fringe. The knit/purl pattern is mostly strips of garter stitch, but the short rows make for occasional bits of 4 by 4 ribbing.

This pattern is a part of Lee Meredith's Remixed collection, which is all about making and using recycled yarns, with knit accessory designs meant to work well with those unique yarns, due to their flexible gauge and sizing.
