Parallel Lines is an any-gauge pattern, meaning you can use any weight yarn! The slip-stitch line pattern is the same on both sides of the work, so there is no right side or wrong side, and it's joined in a moebius at the end. The cowl can be made as big as you want it, both length and width, and can be worn long or looped twice around your neck for extra warmth. Make it with a self-striping yarn, use up leftover scraps, or stripe between 2 yarns - it works great for striping between a solid and a self-striping yarn, like the grey and rainbow sample you see here.

This pattern is a part of Lee Meredith's Remixed collection, which is all about making and using recycled yarns, with knit accessory designs meant to work well with those unique yarns, due to their flexible gauge and sizing.

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Parallel Lines by Lee Meredith

- ▶ moebius loop scarf
- ▶ for any gauge
- ▶ wide as you want
- ▶ use any yarn
- ▶ slip-stitch pattern
- ▶ stripe it or not
- ▶ simple short rows

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
